

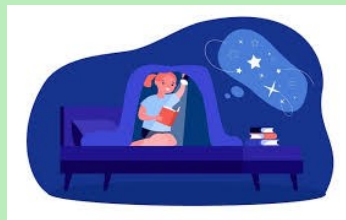


Seaford Primary school Reading Newsletter

Welcome to our third Seaford Primary Reading Newsletter this year.

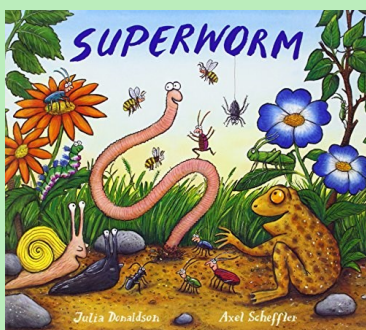
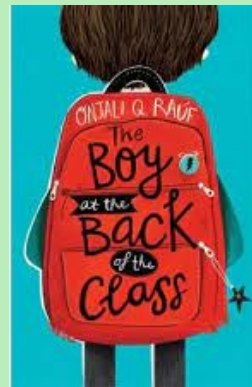
We hope that the cold weather we've had has encouraged lots of cosy reading under blankets.

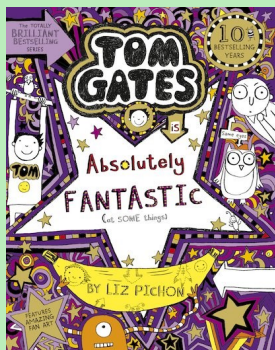
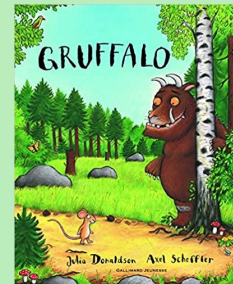
This is my favourite book because I love the illustrations. I definitely rate this a 9/10!
