

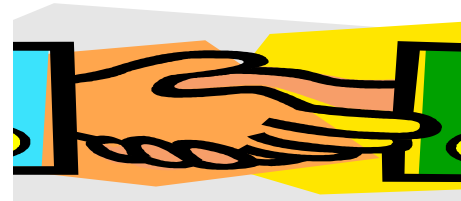


A tough term!
