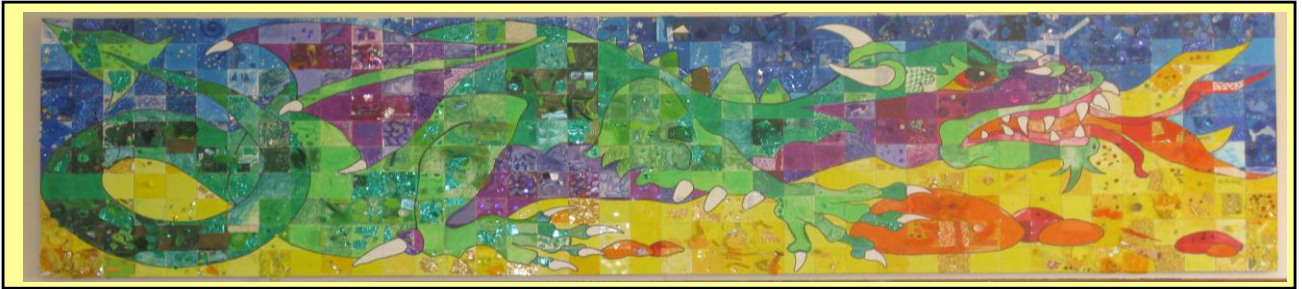




**Welcome back.** Term 5 promises to be an eventful and fun packed one, indeed we have all enjoyed a fantastic Arts week this week.....more details below.

### Uniform and PE kit.

This term we are being very strict about school uniform and PE kit. Last term the standard of uniform and particularly PE kit slipped quite a lot. Below I have copied the Uniform paragraph from the school prospectus. This describes the uniform rules for Seaford Primary School. Our expectation is that all children will wear the correct uniform and PE kit at all times. Thank you.

"Uniform is worn by all pupils, we believe this gives the school an identity and encourages the children to take pride in both their appearance and their school. The school colours are dark green and gold.

- Grey or black trousers/shorts/pinafores/skirts
- Dark green sweatshirt/jumper/cardigan\*
- White shirts/polo shirts/blouses
- Black school shoes

It is essential that a suitable change of clothing is available for PE and games activities. The PE kit must be kept in a named bag. All children wear:

- Green shorts\*
- Yellow t-shirt\*
- Black or white plimsolls
- Green Track suit for cold weather\*

\*These items can be purchased from the school office.

**For reasons of safety and security, jewellery must not be worn but children may wear a watch. Children with pierced ears may wear a single plain stud in each ear."**
