

PRIVACY NOTICE

Seaford Primary School processes personal information about its pupils and is a 'data controller' for the purposes of the Data Protection Act 1998. We collect information from you and may receive information about you and your child from their previous school.

We hold and use your information to support your child's teaching and learning, monitor and report on how well they are doing, provide them with pastoral care and to assess how well the school is doing.

The information we hold includes your child's contact details, national curriculum assessment results, attendance information¹, their ethnic group, special educational needs and any relevant medical information.

We will not give information about you or your child to anyone outside the school without your permission unless the law and our rules permit it. We are required by law to pass some of your information to East Sussex County Council and to the Department for Children, Schools and Families (DCSF).
